Competition from the job market is one reason why some employees look for other jobs. High levels of unemployment mean that it would often be cheaper for an employer to hire someone else to do the same work. This naturally has a negative psychological effect on employees. It can result in their looking for new jobs that gives the sense of security in the workplace.

Increased competition caused by globalisation is also significant. Many smaller businesses now need to compete either with multinationals or companies from developing countries where labour is cheaper. The effect of this on employees is that they know they may be made redundant if the business they work for fails. This is not only stressful, but can also lead to the decline in employees' loyalty to the company they work in.
